



Public Notice:

**Amendment to the NBCA Billing for Services Standard of Practice
Fee Arrangements**

Effective 08 July 2024

The NBCA Board of Directors have approved an amendment to the [Billing for Services Standard of Practice Fee Arrangements](#).

Effective 08 July 2024, New Brunswick Chiropractors are no longer able to offer pre-paid billing arrangement to patients, whether oral or in writing, covering more than one (1) office visit at a time.

Prior to the approved amendment, members were permitted to offer pre-paid billing arrangements to patients that could cover up to twelve (12) office visits or less, provided the billing arrangement was wholly at the option of the patient and was not a condition of the member providing care.

The NBCA acknowledges that there will be a transition period for patients who have entered into billing arrangements with members. Terms for Implementation for pre-existing billing arrangements can be found here: [Terms for Implementation of amendment](#). The duration and/or number of office visits for existing arrangements must not be extended beyond the time frame that was established prior to the implantation of the amendment and all arrangements must be fully terminated one year following the date the changes were implemented. These changes apply to all members (NB chiropractors) and patients who wish to terminate an existing billing arrangement may do so.
