NOTICE OF LICENSE SUSPENSION

A hearing of the Discipline Committee of the New Brunswick Chiropractors Association was convened on Friday, September 06, 2019 in Moncton, N.B. to consider the matter of a complaint against **NATASHA GOUDREAU, D.C.**

The complaint alleged that Dr. Goudreau had an improper relationship with a patient. Dr. Goudreau admitted to the Committee that she allowed a relationship to develop with an individual during a period of time when she provided that individual with occasional chiropractic care. Dr. Goudreau also admitted that she failed to disclose certain material facts to the Association during the initial investigation of the complaint. The Discipline Committee accepted from Dr. Goudreau a plea of guilty to two (2) counts of professional conduct and ordered as follows:

- 1) That Dr. Natasha Goudreau be suspended from the practice of chiropractic medicine for a period of two (2) months to begin on a date to be agreed to between Dr. Goudreau and the Association and to begin no later than three (3) months from the date of the decision;
- 2) That Dr. Natasha Goudreau is ordered to pay 50% of the total costs incurred by the Association for the investigation and hearing of the complaint, including but not limited to legal fees incurred, the total costs to be paid to the Association within a period of one (1) year from the date of the decision;
- 3) That notice of the suspension of Dr. Natasha Goudreau be published by the Association as required by section 48 of *The Chiropractors Act, 1997*, and, in any event, notice is to be distributed to the membership of the Association.

Upon consultation with Dr. Goudreau, the Association confirms that her two (2) month suspension will begin on November 04, 2019.
